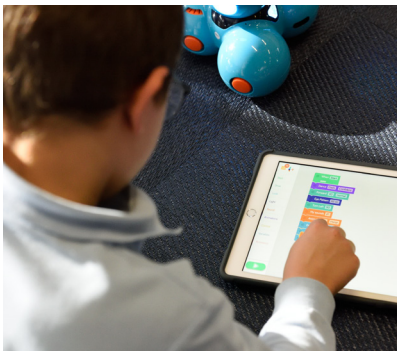
St. Joseph Covid Relief Fund
